significantly reduced if anaesthetic procedures were audited & adapted, found a new study, published in the Journal of Small Animal Practice (JSAP). This in turn could lead to reduced greenhouse gas emissions & financial expenditure. The study "Sustainable veterinary anaesthesia: single centre audit of oxygen & inhaled anaesthetic consumption & comparisons to a hypothetical model", retrospectively reviewed the records of 100 consecutive anaesthetics at the Queen Mother Hospital for Small Animals, RVC, UK. Matt McMillan, corresponding author for the paper, said: "All inhaled anaesthetic agents are greenhouse gases & by reducing the fresh gas flows we use as much as possible, through the utilisation of rebreathing systems, we can reduce the amount of them released into the atmosphere. Obviously this is only one small part of a practice's environmental impact but it is a proportion that can be readily reduced in an effective, safe & practicable fashion.'

Antioxidant Activity of Hemp (Cannapis sativa L.) seed Oil in Drosophila melanogasterlarvae under Non-Stress and H2O2-Induced Oxidative Stress Conditions⁴

The oil extracted from hemp seeds has significant nutritional and biological properties due to the unique composition of polyunsaturated fatty acids and various antioxidant compounds. The potential of this oil for the prevention of oxidative stress and for the treatment of oxidative-stress-induced ailments is of increasing interest. We analyzed the effects of hemp seed oil on oxidative stress markers and on the life cycle of D.melanogaster under non-stress and hydrogen-peroxide-induced stress conditions. D.melanogaster larvae were exposed to hemp seed oil concentrations ranging from 12.5 to 125 ML/ML. The high levels of linoleic and linolenic acids in the oil are suggested to be responsible for in vivo antioxidant effects. Taken together, the results show that hemp seed oil is effective for reducing oxidative stress at the cellular level, thus supporting the hypothesis. The obtained results point to the potential of hemp seed oil for the prevention and treatment of conditions caused by the action of ROS.
